In 1998 he joined the Compañía de Danza de Baja California and in 2002 he was promoted to Principal Dancer. In 2003 he joined the California Ballet Company where by mid-season he was promoted to the rank of Soloist. His repertoire includes featured roles in full length ballets such as The Nutcracker, Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty, Midsummer Night's Dream, Romeo and Juliet, Carmen, Cinderella, Beauty and the Beast, Giselle, Paquita, The Firebird, Tarantela, Who Cares, Ballet Imperial, Spanish Serenades, Suite Vivaldi among many others. Mr. Infante has also appeared as a Guest in The Youth American Grand Prix, Festival Ballet Theatre, The San Diego Symphony, The San Diego Opera, The Ballet Conservatory of San Diego, New West Ballet Theatre, Merced Civic Ballet, San Francisco Youth Ballet Theatre, The California Ballet School, Intercity Ballet Theatre and in The International Mainly Mozart Festival.

He received the "Dancer of the Year Award" presented by The California Ballet and was part of an International Cultural Exchange in Munich, Germany.
